Building Lives



Since 1999 **Project REBUILD** has been removing barriers to educational and career success for at-risk youth in Stark County. Our program focuses on youth ages 16-24, who

are out of school, unemployed or under-employed and want to complete a high school diploma or G.E.D. and learn marketable skills in the construction trades.

Project REBUILD operates as a YouthBuild U.S.A. affiliate offering a holistic service approach to change a youth's life. The services address factors that hinder academic and personal success and demonstrate an ability to improve student outcomes and their quality of life.

Most youth enrolled in our program must be working toward a high school diploma or GED. They spend about four days per week learning the construction skills that will enable them to earn a PACT (Pre-Apprenticeship Construction Training) Certification thru the NAHB. The certification is recognized nationwide.

Project REBUILD provides youth a construction trades pre-apprenticeship opportunity as part of their education. A network of partners, including the City of Canton, Stark Metropolitan Housing Authority, the area construction industry and more

than 30 other community partnerships provide opportunities to rehab, remodel and build new housing for low and moderate income families as part of neighborhood revitalization efforts.

We teach and promote the latest in construction techniques, including green building methods.

Our construction crews are licensed, bonded and insured. Skilled construction professionals oversee production and supervise the student work crews. The students are trained in building site preparation, demolition, rough and finish carpentry, drywall, painting, interior/exterior finishing, and landscaping.
