



“BUILDING A FUTURE” SCHOLARSHIP FUND In Honor of Carolyn Hess, Founder of Project REBUILD Inc.

In 1998 Carolyn made a leap of faith and quit her full time job to follow a dream. She was appalled that area high school dropout rates exceeded 50%. Her friend, former Ohio First Lady Hope Taft, suggested Carolyn look at a program in Dayton that was aligned with AmeriCorps and YouthBuild USA. That model focused on those youth who had not found success in standard educational settings. Carolyn hoped it was a model that would help Stark County dropouts and committed to spend a year as an intern at the Dayton organization.

When she returned to Canton Project REBUILD was born. She worked out of her home for a couple of years, slowly building the program to what it is today. The mission of Project REBUILD is to re-engage young people between the ages of 16-24 years old to earn a high school diploma or GED and acquire marketable skills in construction technologies.

Since the beginning, Project REBUILD as a YouthBuild USA Affiliate has focused on “building” the lives of young people and providing them the tools to become successful. In 2010 the “Building a Future” Scholarship Fund was created to provide another tool towards success.

To be considered for the scholarship, the following must apply:

- Applicant must be a current or former participant of the Project REBUILD, Inc. Construction Training Program
- Applicant must have successfully completed a minimum of one semester or quarter at a college, tech/trade school or university
- Scholarship funds will be paid directly to the college or university applicant attends
- The application package must include the following attachments
 - Two letters of recommendation (teachers, clergy, mentors, job supervisors, etc.). The letters should include the writer’s contact information for verification and follow up.(current Project REBUILD staff are not eligible to write letters of recommendations)
 - Academic transcript or current grades of the most recent completed semester/quarter
